- Supportive services to help you succeed

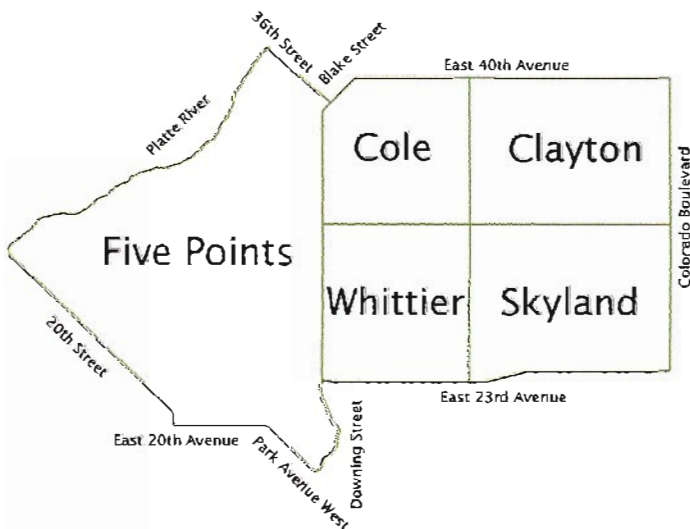


Who can participate?
